Long Beach City College, Department of Visual and Media Arts is very pleased to announce a solo exhibition by renowned artist, HK Zamani. HK Zamani served as Gallery Director and adjunct professor. He has made a deep and lasting contribution to the reputation and high esteem in which the college is held; a testament to the commitment that teachers and curators must have in all aspects of their professional lives. HK Zamani has been an inspiration to former, is to current, and will be to future students at Long Beach City College. Although broader in scope, his exhibition will include a selected works made by the artist while employed at LBCC. Iranian-born artist HK Zamani (Habib Kheradyar Zamani) lives and works in Los Angeles. His work is guided by extreme influences ranging from asceticism to psychedelia. He has exhibited in many cities, including New York, San Francisco, Chicago, Berlin, London, Vienna, Prague, Seoul, and Saigon. His work is in the permanent collections of Los Angeles County Museum of Art, Berkeley Museum of Art, and AD&A Museum at UC Santa Barbara. He has received the COLA grant, and the California Community Foundation Getty grant. Zamani is the founder and director of PØST (1995-present), a subversive venue for contemporary art, where nearly five hundred exhibitions have been presented.
